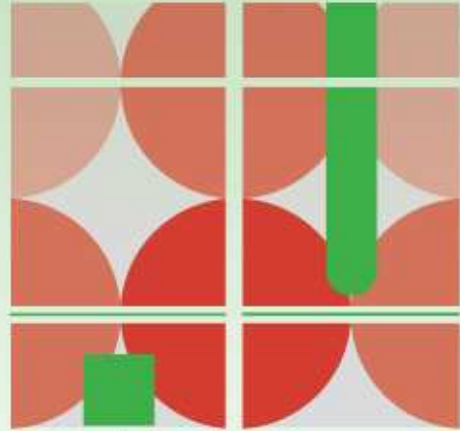

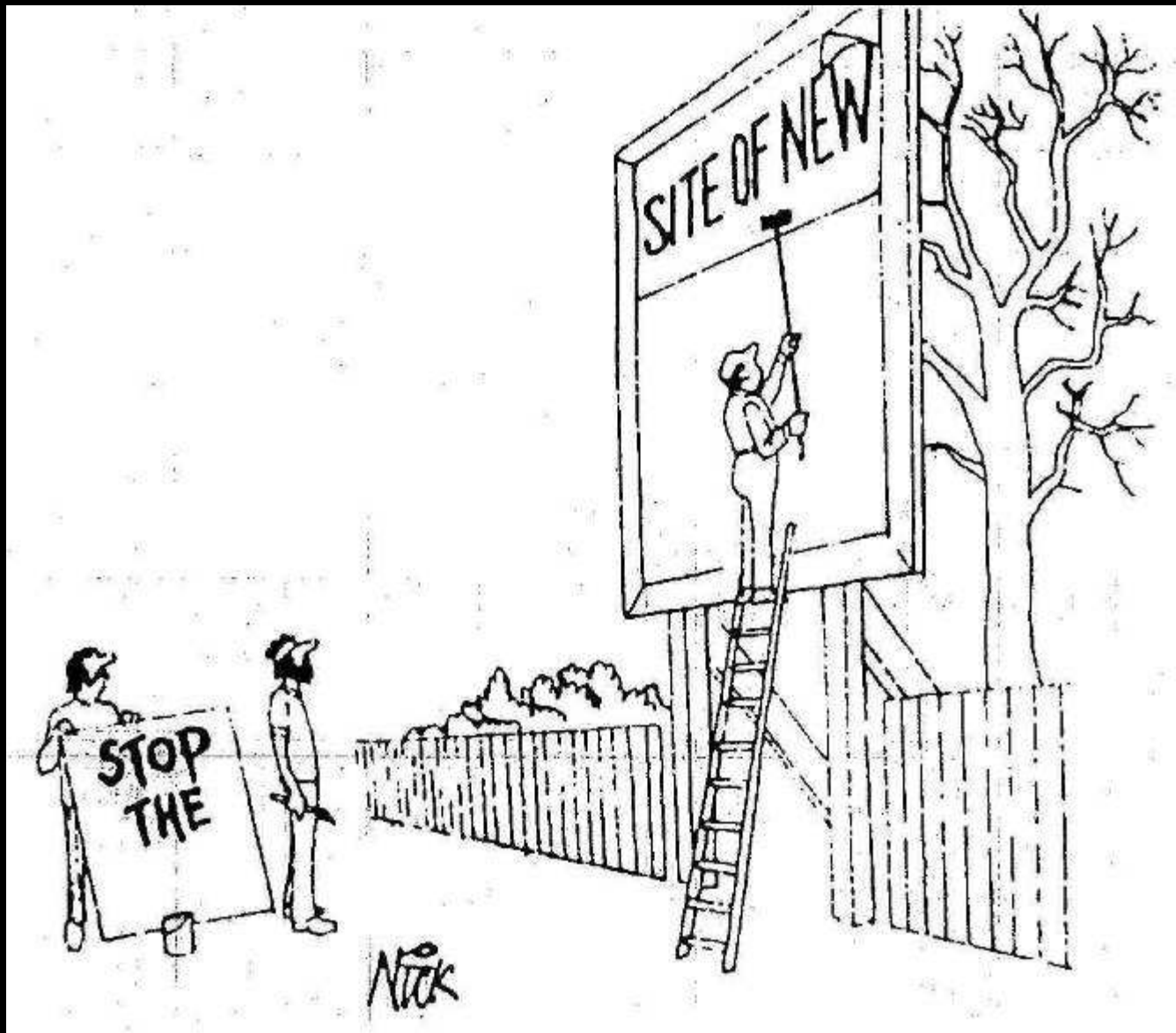

1. A multiple-day collaborative design and planning workshop held on-site and inclusive of all affected stakeholders.

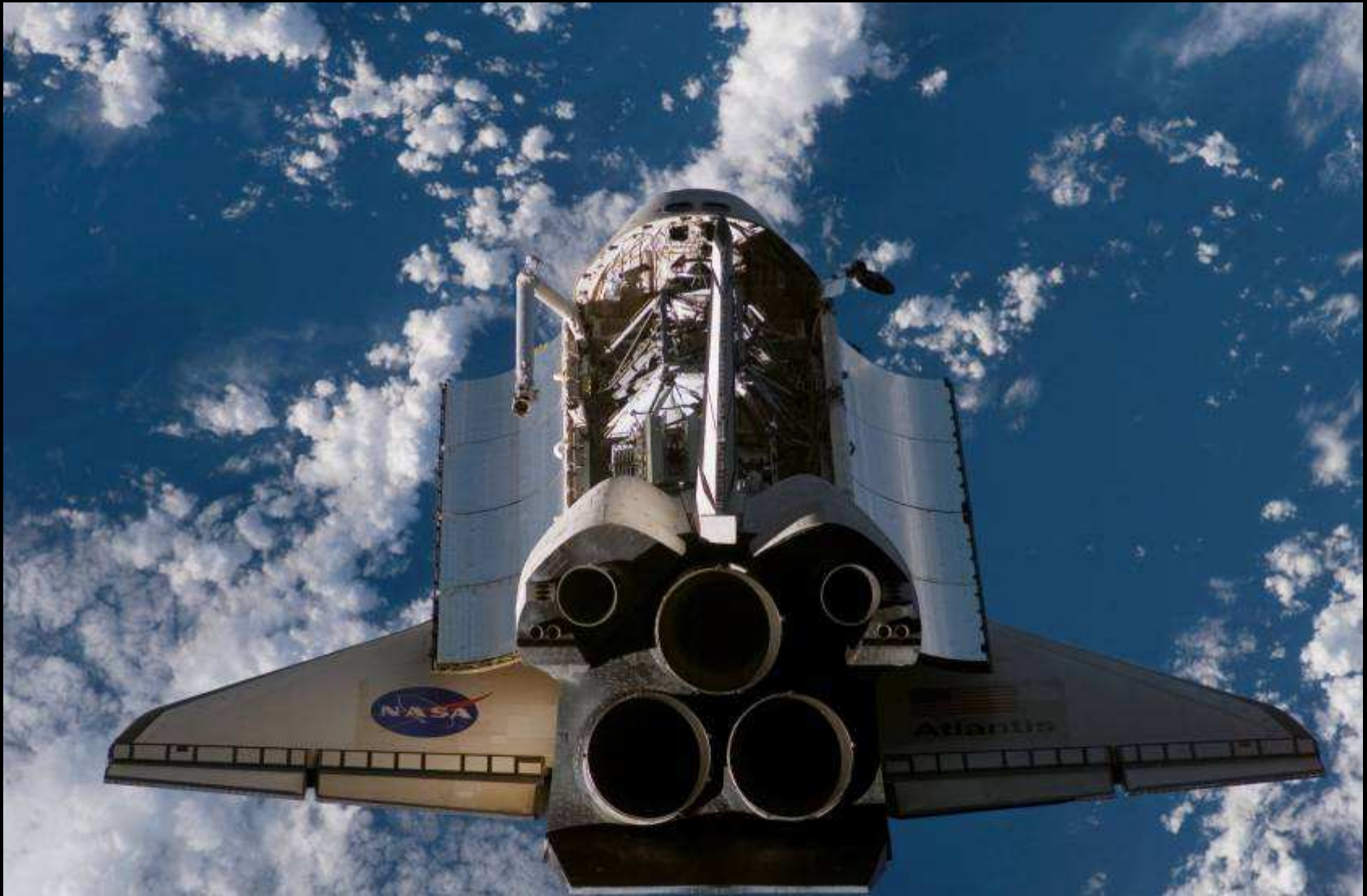
[From French charrette (cart), from Old French.]

It is ten times easier to explain to an ordinary citizen



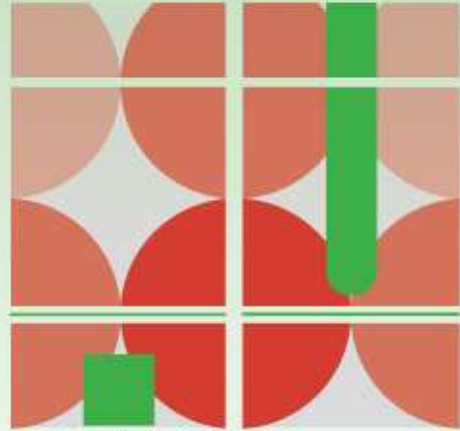
